It originated in France, offering a moderate alternative to extremist violence during times of student unrest, and later spread to the USA and other parts of the world. Of necessity SPIDA maintains a low profile, particularly in Third World countries which do not recognize human rights and where students with minds of their own may be kidnapped, incarcerated, beaten, tortured and murdered by either extremist governments or extremist rebels. CACOMA (Campaign Against Corruption Of Manoy Alipon) is consulting SPIDA in the USA to seek assistance with selecting from known political opponents of Alipon those who merit financial support in the 2010 election. They will also receive other substantial campaign resources.*
